

## **TRAIN FOR A CAREER AS A BUS DRIVER**

Interested? Call us for an interview appointment – you must have a 'clean' UK car driving licence valid for at least 12 months.

The interview comprises a car/van driving assessment, after you have completed an application form. Please ensure that you have your UK Driving Licence with you, and also your Passport or Birth Certificate.

If your interview is successful, you'll be on your way to applying to DVLA for a **Provisional Category D licence**; we will help you to complete the form and book the medical which is part of the DVLA Application process.

After you receive your Provisional Licence from DVLA, we will train you for the various stages:

- Theory Test, Hazard Perception and Case Study
- Practical on-road training with one of our trainers
- Driving test

After you qualify, you'll learn 'on the job' by spending at least the first 7 days with an experienced driver.

### ***Who pays for your training?***

***Nu-Venture will pay for your training. If you leave Nu-Venture within two years, you will be required to pay back a proportionate amount.***

***Alternatively, you can pay for the training yourself should you wish to do so.***
